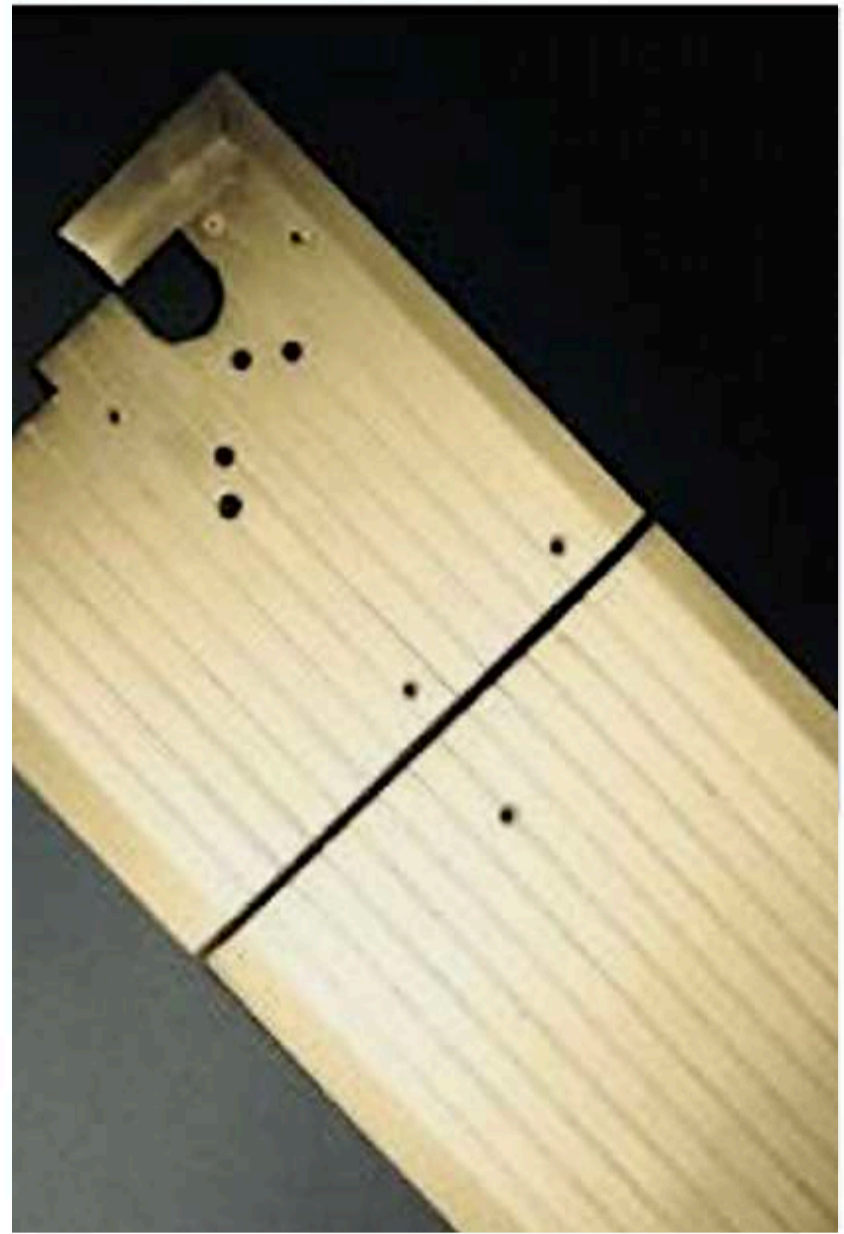

Dawson Custom Thresholds can be fabricated from stainless steel or brass, and include all necessary support channels and anchors. Thresholds can be manufactured in any specified width, up to 120" long (one piece), and are ADA compliant at 1/4", 3/8" or 1/2" high. Thresholds are available with a factory applied #4 satin finish (US32D/US4). Hardware preparation, return miters/ returned closed ends, and door jamb notches are available on all threshold types. Custom machined plate thresholds are also available and can be supplied with a Slipnot finish upon request.

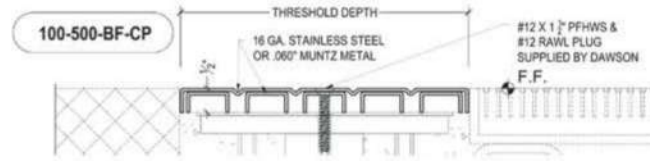

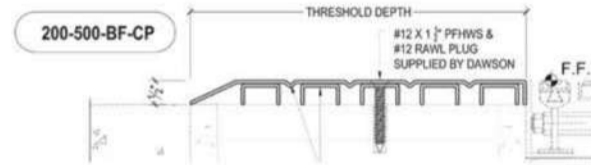


TYPE 100



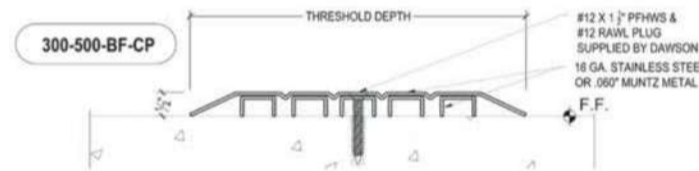
Excellent choice when a floor transition occurs on both sides of the entrance and a recessed type threshold is required

TYPE 200



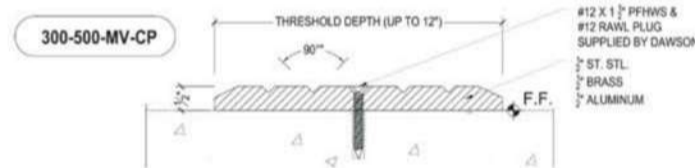
Best choice when a floor transition occurs on interior side of the entrance (walk off mats, carpet, or tile).

TYPE 300



Standard saddle type threshold best used on flat, solid floor types

MACHINED THRESHOLDS



Recommended when large voids in the flooring material are present (such as expansion joints or poured curbs) and standard thresholds might collapse — strength and rigidity are key features of this threshold type. Available with slipknot finish.
